3) Matters arising from previous meeting 24th June 2024

There were none

4) CQC Update

- ➤ The Government is reviewing the CQC system as many GP have raised complaints / concerns regarding current CQC inspection process, and they have staff shortages.
- No date for inspection has been notified.

5) PPG Recruitment

The summer event had proved successful and a lot of interest had be shown. Dr I Ojo was going to follow up with these patients re the next PPG meeting and the Chair offered to help

6) Staffing

➤ No significant changes to staff except for receptionists – two on maternity leave but cover has been found

7) Practice Primary Care Service

Dr Ojo explained the Practice Proactive care for vulnerable patients including hospitalisation, housebound patients, those helped by neighbours, and those with end-of-life conditions. The surgery has MDT meetings which includes the other local surgeries in the Crystal palace Neighbourhood (Upper Norwood and Auckland), to discuss care for these patients.

8) Patient Access

- > Dr Ojo explained the processes for registering new patients saying it was now much more thorough eg getting information about patients lifestyle eg smoking and weight as well as health records
- Dr Ojo said there was a lot of flexibility about how patients were treated with online, telephone, walk-in and video options available with the six practice hub allowing appoints at more days and times

9) Appointments

- There had been some unused slots but this was obviously not the case when Doctors were on leave
- Where possible patients were directed to see the nurse, physio or other staff rather than the GPs

- The standard practice was a two week wait for non-urgent appointments
- Patients were encouraged to undergo blood tests at the surgery as they are more thorough than hospitals

10) Covid 19 and other communicable diseases

- There are financial constraints on when flu vaccinations and to avoid wastage, RSV, a new vaccine for respiratory infections for the vulnerable is being given the priority. The current guideline is to give RSV vaccine first, before flu.
- COVID vaccinations are still available to the old and vulnerable. The practice is working with the PCN and relevant services to vaccinate the housebound patients.
